

Examples of Required Documents for Health Coverage Application

- Proof of home address in San Mateo County
- Proof of identification
- Proof of income
- Proof of U.S. resident status or citizenship

Document with home address in San Mateo County

This must have a date within 45 days before application date
(*not required for CA ID or driver's license*)

Choose one:

- California driver's license or I.D. card
- Utility bill (phone, PG&E, or water bill)
- Rent or mortgage receipt
- Credit card bill or bank statement
- Car registration
- Insurance documents
- School records or letters
- Medical bill from last 3 months (except San Mateo Medical Center)
- Housing/In-Kind Income Verification form with utility bill with name of person providing financial support
- *Homeless applicants*: a letter or document from an agency that indicates you are receiving services

Proof of identification - original document or certified copy:

Choose one:

- Birth certificate or baptism certificate
- California driver's license or I.D. card
- Passport
- National identity card
- Social Security card (must bring with one of the above)

Documents with income

This must have a date within 45 days before application date (*except for income tax forms*)

Bring all that apply :

- Employment pay check stub
- Statement of Earnings form
- Income tax return from last year (state or federal; or employee W-2 form)
- Housing/In-Kind Income Verification form
- Government check stub or letter (i.e. Social Security, State Disability, unemployment pay stub)
- Net profit and loss statement (last 3 months)
- Employer letter or statement of pay frequency and gross amount
- Other types of income: pension, alimony, child support, insurance, etc)

Proof of permanent resident status or citizenship

Original document or certified copy

Bring one:

If you are a U.S. citizen:

- a) birth certificate
- b) certificate of naturalization
- c) certificate of citizenship
- d) U.S. passport

If you are not a citizen:

- a) U.S. Residency Card
